Detailed description: This block contains the musical notation for measures 5 through 8. Detailed description: This block contains the musical notation for measures 9 through 12. The instrumentation remains the same as in the previous block. In measure 9, the Piccolo and Flute 3 parts have trills. Flute 1 and 2 play eighth-note patterns in measure 9, followed by quarter-note patterns in measures 10, 11, and 12. Flute 4, Alto Flute 1, and Alto Flute 2 play eighth-note patterns in measure 9, followed by quarter-note patterns in measures 10, 11, and 12.
